<p><b><u>High Contrast Mode:</u></b> Vision, changes background color</p> <p><b><u>Screen Magnifier:</u></b> Vision. Control + to zoom in , Ctrl - to zoom out</p> <p><b><u>Onscreen Keyboard:</u></b> tactile, touch screen</p> <p><b><u>Automatic Clicks:</u></b> tactile, OT</p> <p><b><u>Large mouse cursor:</u></b> visual, ADHD</p> <p><b><u>Highlight mouse cursor:</u></b> visual, ADHD</p> <p><b><u>ChromeVox:</u></b> Text to speech, spoken feedback</p>	<p><b><u>VOICE TYPING</u></b></p> <p><b>Use:</b> for students who have a hard time physically typing or spelling.</p> <p><b><u>PUPIL PREF:</u></b> Google Doc <b>add-on</b>.</p> <p><b>Use:</b> Visual Impairment. Change background color to reduce visual stress.</p> <p><b><u>READER:</u></b> Google Doc <b>add-on</b></p> <p><b>Use:</b> Reads text in your Google Doc.</p> <p>*Chelsea Market* font is similar to Open Dyslexic</p>	<p><b><u>Read a Loud:</u></b> Web page text to speech voice reader(works on Google Doc's too)</p> <p><b><u>Announcify:</u></b> Web page reader, blurs out unwanted text or images. Great for students with ADHD.</p> <p><b><u>Visor:</u></b> Screen dimmer and reading aid, may help with fluency, eye-strain &amp; reading.</p> <p><b><u>Beeline Reader:</u></b> Applies color gradient from beginning to end of text. Allows you to read more quickly, Built in OpenDyslexic Font. Works with Google Docs.</p> <p><b><u>OpenDyslexic:</u></b> Overrides website fonts. Not on Google Docs.</p> <p><b><u>Google Dictionary by Google:</u></b> Extension. Double click any word to view its definition. Add your words to the bank. Supports Foreign languages. Translates.</p> <p><b><u>Co:Writer</u></b> (\$4.99 m/o): word prediction works with Google Doc</p>
